Sasha – there is a lot of interest in starting a Snow Girls group. Would be involved in Piloting that. Could be a way to promote membership.

Allan – QR codes on sign posts for donations. We are looking into this – planning to link to the trail karma page.

Kalin – Has there been an analysis of the economic benefit of mt biking in the community (bike shops, tourism, etc.)? Thinking of membership – is there a grooming schedule or some way to show more of the grooming and maintenance. --> This could be a bit more of a communications piece. Need to promote the value of the work that CMBC does, and the process behind the trail maintenance.

Hilary – urban cycling has accessed funding for feasibility studies. Could possibly access some funds to do this kind of economic analysis of the value of cycling.

Could canvas folks for memberships at the bike shops during the first couple weeks of the summer when trails are drying out. (would volunteer to help with that)

Megan – have signs at major trailheads saying "groomed by CMBC". --> QR code could lead to trailforks.

Need to have CMBC more nominally attached to trailforks, trails more generally

Suggestion that Board reach out to general membership for assistance with specific tasks (applications, organizing QR codes, member sign up, etc.) – rather than only relying on board members to do this

- Is there a list of what people want to volunteer for when they sign up for a membership?

Is there a way to send out an email reminder to get memberships, reminders about the AGM – more smaller reminder notification emails (rather than having everything on Facebook). – need to share information in different ways).

Devin – perhaps there is a need for more education on how to use trailforks to check grooming.

Steven – is there a way to build longer trails –

- Could there be a set of routes? On CMBC website or at bike shop or through tourism website that link trails together
- Icycle started a recommended routes QR code trailforks and all trails – could Icycle and CMBC work on this together? Board to coordinate with Icycle on this
